He was selected by the office of the former Governor of Florida, Jeb Bush, to assist in promoting professionalism in law enforcement, and was recognized by the National Center for Women and Policing for promoting women in the workplace and received the coveted "Breaking the Glass Ceiling" award.

Andy has been a guest lecturer for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Southern Police Institute, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., the Commission on Florida Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, and many other organizations.
