Background and Professional Experience

Gregory J. Johnsen graduated Barry University in 1990 Magna Cum Laude, completing dual majors in prelaw and history in just three years. Greg graduated from University of Miami School of law in 1993 Cum Laude. Greg became a practicing attorney in 1993. He originally started practicing in the areas of civil litigation and personal injury, representing both plaintiffs and defendants.

Greg began practicing workers compensation law in 1995 and represented employers, carriers, and claimants. In 2006, Greg was hired by the Division of Administrative Hearings as a State Mediator.
